






<p>Language and Literacy activities including:</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personal reading in class. Discuss and share favourite authors and genres of text. Present a book review to class to encourage a wider choice for personal reading. • Listening and talking in cooperative learning groups. Discuss 'what makes a good class' and use this to develop P7 class charter during Oracy lessons. • Establish spelling groups. Test Nelson spelling words and work on personal spelling word lists. • Write storyboards for short films; concentrate on sound, setting, story, colour, camera, and character. • Write short stories and poems about personal and imaginative events. Focus on word choice and using what we know to explore how words and stories make us feel. 		<p>Mathematics and Numeracy activities including:</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revision of number processes. Look at digits, their place value, reading, recording, sequencing, adding and subtracting numbers up to and beyond 6 digits. • Revision of estimation to help addition and subtraction in mental maths. • Establish maths routine. Establish procedures in class and clarify steps for challenge and support. • Practise and revise calculations using the four operations and be able to explain steps to a partner. Discuss and use BODMAS. Begin money topic to examine profit and loss as part of Enterprise project. • Introduce Problem Solving strategies and discuss the importance of 'showing all my working'. 		
<p>Health & Wellbeing activities including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revisit school motto: Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe. Play games to encourage praise, participation, group success and class success. • Teach roles, especially praise and encouragement. • As we start our Film project, establish roles and responsibilities to enable everyone to feel part of a team and valued in the class for their skills. • Physical activities through PE sessions and outdoor learning / maintenance tasks in Nature's Wood. Focus on teamwork and responsibility. 		<p>Contexts for Learning: </p> <p>This term P7 and P6 will be participating in a series of workshops run by the Scottish Youth Film Foundation. Their work in our school will help our learners to understand films, the most prominent means of communication in the 21st century.</p> <p>The staff will teach our P7 class how to read film as a text and take them through the process of producing their own film.
