- > Check written work against success criteria.
- Describe their classroom and what's in their school in French.

Numeracy- This term the class will:

- > Continue to develop number bonds and times table knowledge
- > Learn to tell the time on an analogue and a digital clock.
- Learn to estimate and measure length, area, weight and volume.
- Describe the features of 2D and 3D shapes .
- Learn to spot and extend number and symbol patterns.
- Recognise symmetry and create symmetrical shapes and pictures.


Health & Wellbeing- This term the class will:
