S1 Visit to Dundee Repertory Theatre: 'Jekyll and Hyde' - Thursday 8th February 2024

As a part of the Breadalbane Guarantee, the English department are pleased to inform you that we have organised a theatre trip for our S1 year group to see a performance of Jekyll and Hyde at the Dundee Repertory Theatre on Thursday 8th February.

We will be travelling to Dundee by bus, leaving Breadalbane at 12.45pm and returning at approximately 6.00pm. All pupils attending the performance will be allowed out of lessons at 12.15pm to eat their lunch and pupils can either bring their own packed lunch or purchase refreshments at FoodToGo, pre-ordering at breaktime if required. Packed lunches can also be supplied by Tayside Contracts and paid for via ParentPay. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch can be provided for the trip in place of the in-school lunch. If you would like to order a packed lunch, please complete the form here and return as soon as possible.

All pupils must be dressed appropriately in school uniform.

As we will return after the end of the school day, please ensure there are arrangements in place to collect your child. Pupils will have the opportunity to be dropped off at Birnam, Ballinluig, Grandfully or return to the school and they will be asked to communicate with their parents via their mobile phones regarding any delays to the return time.

Thanks to the Parent Council, the cost of the bus travel has been subsidised in full, reducing the cost of this trip to £12.00 per pupil. To try and ensure that even this cost is not prohibitive for anyone, the school will pay this fee in the first instance. However, we would ask that if you are able to do so, to please contribute towards the total expenditure via ParentPay. A payment item has been set up to allow payments of £1 - £12 and all contributions are gratefully received.

This trip is covered by the Annual Consent Form completed at the beginning of the school year. If you have returned your form and require changes to be made, please contact the School Office.

As this experience is an enhancement to the school curriculum and is delivered on a normal school day, attendance is compulsory for all pupils, and we urge all pupils to take advantage of this opportunity. If you wish to withdraw consent for your child to take part in the activity, or wish for your child to be dropped off on the way back to school, please email breadalbane@pkc.gov.uk by 5pm on Wednesday 31st January.
